



## PJAA History

PJAA (Paramount Junior Athletic Association) is a non-profit organization that works in conjunction with the City of Paramount to provide and serve the community with a youth baseball league ran by an all-volunteer board since 1958. PJAA runs it's league under the PONY umbrella (Protecting Our Nation's Youth). Our league serves ages 3-4 years (Ragball or T-Ball), 5-6 years (Shetland), 7-8 years (Pinto), 9-10 years (Mustang), 11-12 years (Bronco) and 13-14 years (Pony) divisions.

Our goal at PJAA is to provide our youth in The City Paramount, CA. and surrounding areas, an opportunity to learn baseball, sportsmanship, and teamwork, coupled with a strong effort to enforce homework and good grades. Our league is a "recreational league" which means that all who sign up can play. We keep our fees down with the help of funding from the City of Paramount if we keep our signups to 75% Paramount Residents.

Your "registration fee & uniform fee" gets your youth a full uniform (cap, jersey, pants, belt, and socks), a trophy & yearbook, and an opportunity to represent the ALLSTAR team chosen by the coaches and board to play in tournaments throughout the summer.

Our spring season generally runs from February to June. Signups are primarily in the month of January. We offer a Fall Ball (or winter ball) during the months of October and November. The signups for this is generally in September. We have great Opening and Closing Day ceremonies with entertainment, guest speakers, and City Council and Mayoral Support.
